**Iranian Playwright Ezzat
Goushegir to Present at
Antioch**

Antioch College Theater Department presents guest artist /director Meredith Alexander and the performance of *Maryam's Pregnancy*, written by Iranian playwright Ezzat Goushegir at 3 p.m. and 8 p.m., Friday, March 6 in the theater. Admission is \$4 to the general public; \$2 for seniors and students; CG members free.

Meredith Alexander came upon the script of *Maryam's Pregnancy* while directing *Twelfth Night* at the University of Iowa. This production happened to be concurrent with the university's world famous playwright's festival. Alexander was exposed to the work of Iranian playwright Ezzat Goushegir. She was attracted to its 'style, non-realistic and epic' as well as the script of *Maryam's Pregnancy*. Ms. Goushegir, who came to the United States from Iran in 1986, now regularly collaborates with director Meredith Alexander in a process that will include performances this spring at the Antioch Theater.
